Eligibility:

Criteria:

Any one or combination of the following:

- Participated voluntarily in community/professional/service organizations
- Contributed materially to community/professional/service organizations
- Engaged in a single special act or service that impacts the community
- Created or supported an innovative program, system, or facility that benefits and enhances the community
- Served the community in a capacity beyond job requirements
- Fostered positive community relationships
- Enhanced or supported community improvements
- Introduced or implemented innovations in the community
